

SELECTMEN'S MEETING MINUTES

June 27, 2022

- Meeting Called to Order at: 6:30 PM
- Selectpersons Present: Mike Gardner, Brent Brockway, Scott Cyrway
- Others present: Leonard Dow, Nate Manzer, Hilton Drake, Brian Kaczmarek, Jana Atwood

- Accepted and Signed the Disbursement Warrant for June 13, 2022
- Accepted Minutes of the June 13, 2022, Selectman's Meeting.

- It was Voted on to set the next meeting for July 11, 2022, at 6:30 PM

- Road Commissioner's Report:

There were repairs done to a culvert and a pothole was patched on the Bog Rd. Roadside mowing completed. Road signs were repaired and several signs were ordered (signs are on backorder). There was discussion concerning the purchase of a backhoe and dump truck for the town.

Abbott Road bids were opened: Two bids were submitted. Northeast Paving submitted a bid for \$22,176.00 and by Manzer's Fine Grade and Earthwork submitted a bid for \$21,014.40.

The bid was awarded to Manzer's Fine Grade and Earthwork for \$21,014.40

- It was voted on to pay the moderator for the Special town Election a flat rate of \$75.00
- The Selectmen voted to accept Peter Nerber's resignation as ACO. The Selectmen voted to appoint Rachel Weaver as the new Animal Control Officer.
- The Selectmen voted to appoint members for a School Withdrawal Committee. The appointed members are as follows: Kara Kugelmeyer, Michael Gardner, and Scott Corey.
- There was discussion to put together a Bicentennial Celebration Committee. Hilton Drake suggested the Field Day Committee will work with the Bicentennial

Celebration Committee with funding. Beverly Bradstreet, Andy Clark, and Bob & Pam Wallace expressed interest in serving on the Committee.

- There was discussion of hiring a professional cleaning service to deep clean the Besse Building. The Selectmen will reach out to various cleaning services in the area to get quotes for the job.
- Public Comments: There were no public comments.
- Other Business:
 - Leonard Dow, from the Lion's Club, was present to express a desire to number each of the homes in the town to help aid in EMS locating homes in the event of an emergency. He suggested funding come from the Lion's Club, Private Donors, and potentially from ARPA funds if it's approved. The Selectmen will discuss and consider the proposal.
 - A Gentleman with property on the Marks Road asked if the town would develop and maintain the discontinued portion of the road if he decided to build. Scott is to investigate the status of an LD drawn up on the topic of discontinued roads and the responsibilities of towns in that matter.
