

***Selectpersons Meeting***  
***April 10, 2013***

**Call to order: Mary Lee Rounds called the meeting to order at 6:00 PM**

**Selectpersons present:** Mary Lee Rounds, Beverly Bradstreet, and Mike Getchell

**Also in attendance:** Fire Chief Andy Clark and CEO Mike Spaulding.

Minutes from Select Board meeting on March 25, 2013 was accepted.

Mary Lee Rounds made a motion to get a price to paint the small meeting room and install pull-down shades. Mike Getchell 2<sup>nd</sup> the motion, all in favor and passed.

A question has arisen about workers compensation for Winston Higgins helpers. Mary Lee Rounds will contact MMA concerning the matter.

We received a bid form Poulins Lawn and Yard to mow the grass around the fire department for the amount of \$750.00. Andy Clark said he will be satisfied if it is mowed around the flag pole area to save the town some money. Mike Spaulding and Mike Getchell have tractors with bush hogs and said they are willing to mow the other area free of charge once or twice a year as needed. Mike Getchell will contact Leo Poulin and request a new bid to mow around the flag pole.

Mary Lee Rounds made a motion to accept the bids for cemetery mowing and maintenance. Mike Getchell 2<sup>nd</sup> the motion. All in favor and passed

Mike Getchell will rope off the field in back of the Besse Building and put up no parking signs. The ropes and signs will be removed when the field is dry enough to park without rutting up the soil. Mike will also install a door closer on the front door of the Besse Building.

Dialog was held on cleaning the carpets in the Besse Building for the upcoming 100<sup>th</sup> anniversary celebration this fall and to get some of the paint

touched up in the Freeland Drake room. We will seek bids for this work as the celebration gets closer.

We had a discussion about the price of renting the rooms at the Besse Building because of the price of oil to heat the building it might become necessary to ask for higher rental fee and possibility to require the Odd Fellows to contribute money for the heating oil. We do not want to do this but it might become necessary. More discussion and input will be necessary to make the final decision. Public information is welcome.
