

Selectpersons Meeting

January 11, 2021

- Call to order: Meeting was called to order at 6:30 pm
- Selectpersons present: Beverly Bradstreet, Peter Fortin and Wally Linnell
- Also present: Road Commissioner Matt Lee, Fire Chief Andy Clark and Brent Brockway
- Tax sale notices were signed by the selectmen for the property at 9 Cookson Road which foreclosed on December 7, 2020. Wally will post notices in Albion on Tuesday, January 12, 2021, it will be posted on townofalbionmaine.com, Facebook, the Morning Sentinel, and the Town Line.
- The selectmen signed letters to be mailed to Albion Veterans who are recipients of a donation from the Fairfield VFW.
- Asked for suggestions for nominations for the Spirit of America Award.
- Accepted the letter of resignation from Peter Fortin who is resigning as selectman, assessor, and overseer of the poor effective at town meeting on March 20, 2021.
- Read of letter from Efficiency Maine about reimbursements for installation of heat pumps and efficiency lighting for town buildings. Andy Clark will do some research to see if this would be something that could be done in the town office.
- Had discussion about the 2021 annual budget but will wait until the end of January to get final numbers from the 2020 budget.
- The Road Commissioner reported that he will do some patching of town roads. We also discussed projects for the 2021 budget year.
- The Fire Chief informed the selectmen that a generator is gone on the newest fire truck and will need to be replaced. He will get quotes on purchasing a new generator or a rebuilt generator.
- Meeting was adjourned at 7:25 pm.
