

BARKING DOG ORDINANCE

1. No owner or person having custody of any dog kept within the legal limits of the Town shall allow such a dog to unnecessarily annoy or disturb any person by continued or repeated barking or making bothersome loud or unusual noise.
2. When written complaint is signed and sworn to, a Town Officer shall investigate and shall give written notice to the owner or keeper that such annoyance or disturbance must cease.
3. Therefore upon continuation of such annoyance or disturbance, such owner or keeper shall be subject to a penalty found in part four of this ordinance.
4. The violation of this ordinance shall be punishable by a fine of not more than \$100 or less than \$25. Each day of any violation of this ordinance shall constitute a separate offense and the fine shall be returnable to the Town.

The foregoing ordinance was passed at the Annual Town Meeting of the Town of Albion held March 21, 1981.
