

SELECTMAN'S MEETING MINUTES

June 10, 2019

- Meeting was called to order at 6:33pm
- Selectpersons present: Beverly Bradstreet, Kevin Bradstreet, Jeanie Doore
- Also present: Shirley Burbello, Brian Croft, Divina Giggey, Matt Lee, John Roger
- It was voted on to accept the minutes of the May 13, 2019 Selectman's Meeting.
- The CEO was present to discuss the Burbello property on the Unity Road. The Board of Appeals decision from Dec was that one of the buildings was to be removed from the property in the spring as soon as weather permits. A letter was sent informing Ms. Burbello that the time limit had passed. Ms. Burbello was present to ask for more time. It was voted on by the Selectmen to allow the deadline to have one of the buildings removed to be changed. It was approved to change the deadline to July 31, 2019.
- There was discussion about replacing one of the office computers. A quote from Snow Pond Technologies was presented for \$1165.00. It was voted on to table the replacement and contact Snow Pond for a new quote to upgrade the server computer and upgrade the remaining office computers to Windows 10.
- There are 2 properties on the Foreclosure list. One owned by Haig Brochu & Gail Doherty and the other owned by Lillian, Edwin and Arnold McNamara. It was voted on to extend the deadline for Taxes to be paid in full by July 31, 2019. If no payment is made the properties will be foreclosed upon and put out to bid.
- There was some discussion about the solar farm being built in Unity Township. The project will connect to the CMP transmission system at the Albion substation via the current transmission route, in the town of Benton. Albion will not be affected.
- Road Commissioner's Report: Brush cutting, potholes getting filled and culvert work continues throughout town. One entire load of cold patch was put on Foss Hill. Ditching and culvert work continues on the Bog Road and a section of hot top was dug up and returned to dirt. Calcium has been put on some of the dirt roads. Gravel will be brought into the Weymouth Rd, Robbins Rd, Barnes Rd, Tyler Rd and Quaker Hill. Several trees on the Harding Road need to be cut down. All Bridges in town need to be cleaned and dirt shoveled off.
- It was voted on and approved to purchase a pipe saw for culvert work. The Road Commissioner will look for the best price available.
- The next Selectman's Meeting was set for July 22, 2019 at 6:30pm in the Town Office.
- Meeting was adjourned at 8:00pm.
