# Maine Obsolete Pesticide Collections

## Submit Application

- Visit [thinkfirstspraylast.org](http://thinkfirstspraylast.org), email [pesticides@maine.gov](mailto:pesticides@maine.gov), or call 207-287-2731 to register and submit an application. You'll need the chemical name of the products you'd like disposed of.

## Recieve & Review Materials

- In a few weeks, you'll recieve event details with instructions on how to participate. Some documents are required to be on your person with your unwanted materials.

## Come to Event Location

- Visit your designated location during the 2 hour event period with your paperwork and unwanted materials. BPC and DEP staff will assist you and transfer materials to the vendor.

Collections will take place in October, participants will be notified of specific dates and times in an informational packet sent out two weeks before the program. Locations will be set up in Presque Isle, Bangor, Augusta, and Portland. This is not a household hazardous waste event, only pesticides and adjuvants will be accepted.
