

**Selectpersons Meeting
February 27, 2017**

Call to order: Meeting is called to order at 7:04 p.m.

Minutes from the January 23, 2017 meeting were accepted.

An offer from Bill and Kathi Charity to supply and install a fence at the Libby Hill Cemetery at no cost to the town was accepted.

Adam Bradstreet stated that he is willing to take the exam to become Albion's Health Officer.

Voted to hold a Selectmen's meeting on March 27, 2017 to make selectmen's appointments for 2017.

Accepted the resignation of Frank Siviski as a planning board member whose term ended in 2020. A new member will need to be elected for a three year term at annual town meeting to finish out Frank's term.

Voted to accept the state of Maine weight limit on posted roads rule changes.

Signed the warrant for the upcoming annual town meeting on March 17 and 18.

Voted to accept the PUT option for PERC/MRC to accept the buyout from PERC when the contract with them is over.

Code Enforcement Officer Adam Bradstreet requested an increase in the stipend for his CEO/LPI position. Since the budget requests for 2017 are already set, it was suggested to him that it be brought up at town meeting during the discussion of Article 13 at when we vote the amount to raise for payment of town officials.

The meeting was adjourned at 8:10 p.m.
