

Selectpersons Meeting

June 11, 2018

- Call to order: Meeting was called to order at 7:00 p.m.
- Selectpersons present: Beverly Bradstreet and Kevin Bradstreet
- Others present: Road Commissioner Matt Lee, Scott Martin, Jerry Sullivan, Ralph Sullivan
- Accepted minutes of the May 14, 2018 meeting.
- Voted Beverly Bradstreet as Chairman of the Selectboard.
- Opened and accepted a bid from Sullivan's Waste Disposal for weekly curbside collection of trash and transportation of waste to a waste facility and monthly collection of recycling at a fixed site. Five year contract at \$74,880 per year beginning July 1, 2018.
- Signed Roadside Mowing Contract with Aggressive Cuts for summer of 2018 that was accepted at the May 14, 2018 selectman's meeting.
- Scott Martin was here to discuss the Winter Road Maintenance Contract. It was agreed and voted to extend the current contract for 3 more years, same as in the past with a 3% increase in each of the coming 3 years. Discussed that we would work with Nitram on the 400 ton limit of salt the town would purchase if we have a bad winter and more salt is needed.
- Voted to accept and sign a "Resolution of the Town of Albion, Maine Authorizing the Purchase of a Rescue Truck".
- Appointed Brian Croft as the new Albion Health Officer.
- Road Commissioner Matt Lee reported on work he is doing on Albion roads. Brush cutting was started on the Crosby Road, work has been done on the Tyler Road, he is in the process of getting quotes for repairs on the Marks Road, he has been doing grading of the dirt roads. We also discussed needed repairs to the town grader and the town backhoe.
- Discussion of a security system for the town office was tabled until further research can be done.
- Meeting was adjourned at 8:10 pm
