March 23, 2020

- Call to order: Meeting was called to order at 6:35 p.m.

- Elected Beverly Bradstreet as Chairman of the Selectboard for the coming year.

- Voted to accept Adam Higgins proposal for cemetery maintenance for 2020 in the amount of \$20,500.
- Voted to accept Adam Higgins proposal for town office, fire station, and library maintenance for 2020 in the amount of \$1,700.
- Road Commissioner reported that he is patching potholes on town roads and that brush cutting will start soon. Also discussed road maintenance for the coming summer.
- Fire Chief, Andy Clark, reported that he has completed grant proposals for new hose with a 5% match, a new fire engine with a 5% match, and an area communications grant.
- It was voted to have Jeanie Doore, Tax Collector, apply for Rapid Renewal so that Albion residents would be able to renew vehicle registrations online. There will be an additional fee to the resident for using the online renewals service, but they would no longer have come into the town office to reregister their vehicles.
